- Full passive flexion
- Near full active flexion (see photo)
- Can do light ADLs
- Fingers are numb & sensitive
- ① pinky has good blood flow but is always frigid cold
- ② pinky has trigger finger - getting better

It's today.

Thank you again for the great work you did on my hands. I hope to be climbing by next Spring and look forward to this ski season.

As for my Darwin award.... I qualify only as an "At risk survivor", as you can understand with the included CDs.
